Policy 4:175

The Superintendent or designee shall perform fingerprint-based criminal history records information checks and/or screenings required by State law or Board policy for employees. ~~student~~ Student teachers **must provide a copy of a fingerprint-based criminal history report.** ~~students~~ Students doing field or clinical experience other than student teaching; contractors' employees who have direct, daily contact with one or more children; and resource persons and volunteers must provide a valid ID daily. **These visitors will be screened against the sex offender registry and custom databases, including those with custody orders and banned visitor status.** The Board President shall ensure that these checks are completed for the Superintendent. The **Superintendent** ~~He or she~~ shall take appropriate action based on the result of any criminal background check and/or screen.
