Dear Ms. Garcia,

Pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140, I am requesting electronic copies of records concerning **lead testing and lead levels in drinking water at John V. Leigh School, 8151 W. Lawrence Avenue, Norridge, Illinois**, from **January 1, 2020 through the present**.

The primary purpose of this request is to obtain the **actual lead-testing results for individual drinking-water fixtures at Leigh School**, including any results that were elevated and any corrective action taken.

Specifically, please provide:

1. **All lead-in-drinking-water testing results** for Leigh School, including initial testing, follow-up testing, and retesting.
2. **Complete laboratory reports** for all such testing, including:
 - Sample collection date and time
 - Testing date
 - Sample/fixture identification
 - Exact lead concentration in ppb ($\mu\text{g/L}$)
 - Laboratory name
 - Any applicable laboratory certification or accreditation information.
3. A **complete list or inventory of every fixture tested**, including, but not limited to:
 - Drinking fountains
 - Bottle-filling stations
 - Classroom sinks
 - Kitchen/food-service faucets
 - Nurse's office sinks
 - Preschool and kindergarten water sources
 - Any other fixture used or potentially used for drinking or food preparation.
4. All records identifying any fixture or sampling location with a lead result **at or above 5 ppb**, including the specific fixture, date, and result.
5. All records identifying any fixture or sampling location with a lead result **above 15 ppb**, including the specific fixture, date, result, and subsequent action taken.

6. All records documenting **corrective or remedial action** taken in response to lead testing, including:
 - Faucet or drinking-fountain replacement
 - Fixture removal
 - Installation or replacement of water filters
 - Filter specifications and certifications
 - Flushing procedures
 - Plumbing repairs
 - Taking a fixture out of service
 - Follow-up testing after remediation.
7. All communications concerning lead in drinking water at Leigh School between District 80 and:
 - Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA)
 - Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE)
 - Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH)
 - Village of Norridge
 - Cook County Department of Public Health
 - Testing laboratories
 - Plumbing contractors
 - Water-testing consultants or other outside entities.
8. All records concerning the **water service line and plumbing materials serving Leigh School**, including records identifying whether the public and/or private portion of the service line contains or previously contained lead, galvanized steel, copper, or another material.
9. Any **lead service-line inventory, inspection, survey, or assessment** specifically applicable to [8151 W. Lawrence Avenue](#).
10. Any parent, staff, or public notifications concerning **lead in drinking water at Leigh School**, including notifications regarding elevated test results, fixture closures, remediation, filtration, or recommendations concerning use of drinking-water fixtures.
11. Records showing whether Leigh School participated in the **Illinois Lead Testing in School and Child Care Program (ILTSC)** or another state, county, municipal, or district lead-in-water testing program, including sampling plans, applications, results, and correspondence.
12. Any current or recent records (2024–present) indicating whether **all drinking-water fixtures at Leigh School have been tested for lead and whether any fixtures remain subject to remediation, replacement, filtration, or monitoring**.

Please prioritize and provide electronically the **actual laboratory reports and fixture-level lead results**, rather than summaries, where those records are available.

If any responsive records are maintained by another District 80 department, employee, contractor, or governmental entity, please forward this request to the appropriate records custodian or advise me where the request should be directed.

If any portion of this request is denied, please identify the specific statutory exemption relied upon and provide all reasonably segregable, non-exempt portions of the requested records.

Please provide the records electronically by email. If there will be fees exceeding **\$25**, please notify me before incurring those fees.

Thank you for your assistance. Please confirm receipt of this FOIA request.
